## HOW TO REACH THE 'AUTODROMO' OF MONZA FOR THE F1 GP

29 July 2016

Monza Mobilità, together with the municipality of Monza, manages the connection services to the GP circuit, thus creating a direct, fast, and frequent connection: there are no intermediate stops between external parking areas and the circuit.

The advantage is that buses follow especially-created runs in the Monza park in order to avoid traffic. The three available shuttles are in function Friday, Saturday, and Sunday until the end of the event and connect the various parking areas with the 'autodromo'.

**The Black Line** connects the FS Station to the 'autodromo' without intermediate stops (Viale Caviga/Mirabellino inside the Park of Monza). See route: **2-3 e 4 sept 2016**

**The Green Line** connects stops the West parking areas (Via Elvezia, Rondò dei Pini, SS 36) with the 'autodromo' without intermediate (Viale Mirabello inside the Park of Monza). The capacity of these parking areas is limited to 1500 cars: it is suggested to use East car parks, which offer higher capacity. See route: **Saturday 3 sept 2016 ; Sunday 4 sept 2016**

**The Blue Line** connects the East parking areas (Viale delle Industrie – Stadium) with the 'autodromo' without intermediate stops (Viale Mirabello inside the Park of Monza). These car parks offer more the 6.000 places and they are easily reachable by motorways and bypasses (A52 North bypass "San'Alessandro" exit). See route: **friday 2 sept 2016; Saturday 3 sept 2016; Sunday 4 sept 2016**

1. **The Black Line is free for the owners of the pass train ticket (train+shuttle bus) only (see other news at Monza Mobilità website or Trenord official website – [www.trenord.it](http://www.trenord.it) ). The payment of a 5 Euros return ticket for the shuttle is required to those who do not own the pass. The Green and Blue lines are free for those who park in areas which have an arrangement with Monza Mobilità only (West parking areas ticket costs 20 Euros and East parking areas ticket costs 15 Euros); everyone else is required to purchase a return ticket for the shuttle, which costs 5 Euros per person.**

**For those who come by car:**

- **From A4 – West**
- **From A4 – East**
- **From SS36**

**By train.**

There are various possibilities:

1. **From FS "Milano Centrale"**
  - Trains to Monza ( Lecco, Tirano, Chiasso direction) every hour;
  - Special there-and-back trains from "Milano Centrale" to Biassono and Lesmo on Sunday only
2. **From Milano Porta Garibaldi:**

From Milan "Porta Garibaldi" station (that you can reach by MM2 or by railway bypass) trains to Monza (direction Lecco, Bergamo, Chiasso, Molteno, Chiavenna) every 5-10 minutes (20 minutes on Sunday).
3. **From Milan "San Cristoforo/Romolo/Lambrate":**

Trains to Monza "Saronno" direction (line S9) every 30 minutes. At Monza FS Station exit "Porta
